
ENDOMETRIOSIS: THE INVISIBLE ILLNESS

Endometriosis is a chronic and painful disease that occurs when tissue similar to the lining of the uterus starts growing outside of the uterus, where it doesn't belong.1



The estimated total annual cost to society of surgically confirmed endometriosis in Canada.6



Compared to those without endometriosis, in the first year following diagnosis, 71% more individuals with endometriosis had at least one emergency department (ED) visit.

This equates to 9,651 individuals with endometriosis visiting the ED for any reason in the first year after diagnosis vs. 5,652 individuals without endometriosis (P<0.05).
